We objected to a new oil well in the Carrizo Plain, secured stronger protections for Big Sur wilderness, and sought transparency for public lands management.

TECHNICAL LETTERS & REOUESTS



We opposed two commercial logging projects, urged formal protection for a rare plant, and submitted comments against a plan to drill and frack iconic Central Coast landmarks

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUESTS





We requested access to public records regarding oil development on the Carrizo Plain, fracking, commercial logging projects and more.

We joined a chorus of voices from conservation groups around the country defending bedrock environmental protection standards from White House rollbacks.
